Answer: "The Christmas Invasion"

2. What song was playing in the garage when Mickey heard the TARDIS land?

Answer: "Merry Christmas Everybody" by Slade

3. What was the 'something important' the Doctor had to tell Jackie and Mickey when he first exited the TARDIS?

Answer: "Merry Christmas!"

Answer: Opening a Christmas cracker with Rose 13. How did London get a White Christmas?

Answer: Ash fell from the destroyed Sycorax spaceship

A. What is the documentary about David Tenant's first full episode (on the Season One Box Set) called?

Answer: "Backstage at Christmas"

B. In the 2005 Children in Need special, what does the Doctor say about returning Rose home?

Answer: "Consider it a Christmas present"

1. In "The Runaway Bride," how does the Doctor discover it's Christmas?

Answer: Donna criticizes the cabbie for having no Christmas spirit

2. How does Donna feel about Christmas?

Answer: She hates it

3. How does Donna get money for a cab?

Answer: Appealing to a passerby's Christmas spirit

4. What returning enemy threatens the Doctor and kidnaps Donna?

Answer: Father Christmas automaton

5. Two children watch the Doctor save Donna on the motorway. What is the little girl holding?

Answer: An inflatable Santa doll

6. What song is playing when the Doctor and Donna arrive at her wedding reception?

Answer: "Merry Christmas Everybody" by Slade

7. What weapons are used against the guests at the reception?

Answer: Exploding Christmas ornaments

8. What object was "high in the sky, floating so high on Christmas night"?

Answer: The Racnoss spaceship

9. What was H.C. Clemmons to the Racnoss?

Answer: Her Christmas dinner

10. Along with weddings and calendars, what does the Doctor say earthlings use to make sense out of chaos by marking the hours?

Answer: Christmas

11. What did the Racnoss ship appear to be to onlookers (at first)?

Answer: The Christmas star

12. What is the best Christmas present Donna's parents could have?

Answer: Her safe return

13. How did London get a White Christmas for the second year in a row? Answer: Basic atmospheric excitation (created by the Doctor with his sonic screwdriver and TARDIS)

14. What counter-offer does Donna make after turning down the Doctor's invitation to travel with him?

Answer: She invites him to Christmas dinner

Bonus questions:

A. What holiday melody is part of the ambient music during the attack at the reception?

Answer: "Jingle Bells"

B. On the Special Features, who states they watched the episode on Christmas Day?

Answer: Russel T Davies

1. In Voyage of the Damned, what song is playing when the Doctor joins the passengers?

Answer: "Jingle Bells"

2. How does the Captain end his announcement of the ship's current position?

Answer: "Ladies and gentlemen, welcome to Christmas"

3. What Christmas carol does the Captain reference while at the helm?

Answer: "Silent Night"

4. What is the second song we hear playing at the party attended by the Doctor?

Answer: "Winter Wonderland"

5. How does the historian describe Santa?

Answer: "The great god Santa, a creature with fearsome claws..."

6. Why was London deserted at Christmas?

Answer: Everyone was afraid because of the alien invasions of the past two years

7. What did the deadly robots look like?

Answer: Golden angels

8. What did they use as a weapon?

Answer: Their halos

9. Why does the historian say the disaster is "very much in the spirit of Christmas"? Anser: He thinks Christmas is a festival of violence where survival depends on whether one is good or bad (naughty or nice)

10. In response to this statement, how does the Doctor describe Christmas?

Answer: Christmas is a time of peace and thanksgiving (except for the Doctor's own)

11. What does the historian point out when he notices it is midnight?

Answer: It is Christmas Day

12. What claim does the Doctor make when Astrid asks him what Christmas is all about?

Answer: He was there at the origin of Christmas--and got the last room

13. What Christmas tradition is pointed out by the historian when the group is attacked crossing a narrow, collapsing bridge?

Answer: Angels have wings

14. What does Max Capricorn call the impending destruction of Earth?

Answer: The Christmas inferno

15. What does the Queen say when the Titanic flies over Buckingham Palace?

Answer: "Thank you Doctor. Happy Christmas!"

16. What causes this White Christmas?

Answer: The ballast from the Titanic's salvage entering the atmosphere

PART IV

1. In The Next Doctor, what song are the carolers singing when the Doctor strolls through the square?

Answer: "God Rest Ye Merry Gentlemen"

2. What is the answer to the first question the Doctor asks the young boy in the square?

Answer: Christmas Eve

- 3. What does the next Doctor say in farewell after his first encounter with the Doctor? Answer: "Merry Christmas, Mr. Smith"
- 4. What festive holiday item features prominently in the background as the Doctors search the house of Rev. Fairchild?

Answer: A Christmas tree

- 5. What familiar greeting does Mercy Hartigan give during the cemetery slaughter? Answer: "Merry Christmas to you"
- 6. What does Rosita note in the stable with the Doctor and Jackson Lake as the church bells are heard?

Answer: It is Christmas Day

- 7. Why did Miss Hartigan time the rise of the Cyberking for Christmas Day? Answer: It is the perfect day for a birth (with a new message for the people)
- 8. What does the Doctor say when he returns Jackson Lake's son?

Answer: "Merry Christmas!"

9. What does Jackson Lake lead the crowd to cheer to the Doctor "on this Christmas morn"?

Answer: "Bravo, sir!"

10. What invitation did Jackson Lake--twice--extend to the Doctor?

Answer: To join him, his son, and Rosita for a Christmas feast

1. At the beginning of the episode "The End of Time," how does the Narrator describe Christmas?

Answer: A pagan rite to banish the cold and the dark

2. What does Wilfred Mott say would 'make' his Christmas?

Answer: The return of the Doctor

3. What would be 'such a Christmas present' for Joshua Naismith's daughter?

Answer: Harold Saxon's survival

4. Who says, "Christmas is cancelled"?

Answer: Joshua Naismith

5. What kind of headgear does Wilfred wear to meet the bus?

Answer: Reindeer antlers

6. Who traditionally makes a Christmas broadcast?

Answer: The Queen (although in this episode, President Obama does, also)

7. What do the Doctor and Wilfred say to each other in the cafe (to keep from crying)?

Answer: "Merry Christmas"

8. What does the Master say humans do 'so much' of at Christmas?

Answer: Eat

9. What does the Narrator say "came to pass on Christmas Day"?

Answer: The human race ceased to exist

Bonus questions:

A. Describe briefly the DW-themed station identification commercials used in 2009.

Answer: The Doctor harnessing reindeer to pull the TARDIS/ The Doctor digging the TARDIS out of the snow/ Reindeer in front of the TARDIS

B. What was the name of the classic ('60s) Doctor Who episode involving Christmas? Answer: "The Feast of Stephen"

C. Which classic Doctor appeared in commercials of Christmas greetings with his companion?

Answer: The Fourth Doctor, Tom Baker, with Romana and K-9

D. What is the name of the Doctor Who episode that aired December 2010?

Answer: "A Christmas Carol"
